- Resources continue to be put into fisheries management, in particular the Ahu Moana programme. This is an alternative to reserves and includes many stakeholders including lwi.
- We have spoken previously about the Kai ika programme and how we might be involved in the EBOP. Kai
  ika is a programme where fish is filleted for a small fee for anglers and the frames and heads returned to the
  community free of charge. It has been a great way to strengthen relationships between NZSFC, Legacy, and
